Dorothy was born January 12, 1919 in Lowville, the daughter of the late Charles Crane and Sadie Adele (Hall) Gordon. She graduated from Lowville Academy and received her teaching Degree from Oswego Normal School (SUNY Oswego) in 1939. Dorothy taught briefly in a one room school house in Lowville. On September 11, 1943 she married Lt. Doran E. Waugh in Columbus, Georgia. She and Doran purchased Harrisville Hardware Company on December 18, 1946 and operated Waugh's Hardware until their retirement.
